The 2022-2023 school year was full of joyous moments for the Chesapeake Academy community, as we celebrated achievements and looked ahead to new beginnings. The June 2023 "graduation" of Julianne Duvall as the 11th Head of School and the appointment of Trip Cogburn as the 12th leader of Chesapeake Academy was a smooth transition due to the work of the Search Committee, the Board of Trustees, the faculty and staff, and the broader community.

Our Search Committee, under the leadership of Ron Mihills and Bill Chapman, provided such guidance for the search process and transition, making sure that at each turn, our community received updates, accurate information, and invitations to participate in the process.

Thank YOU for being such an integral part of Chesapeake Academy as we continued to work together to ensure our students had the best opportunities and experiences.

You make a difference in the school's ability to stay nimble, responsive, innovative, and constant. Because of you, Chesapeake Academy doesn't miss a beat! We continue to meet the moment, a dynamic place with a creative and optimistic spirit, proud to be a vital and vibrant institution in our community.

The value of a small, independent school in our community is evident, and we showed throughout the search process how we can celebrate all that our school is in the area. We know our students well, provide a nurturing and challenging educational experience, and partner with families to work for our common goals. As families move to the Northern Neck and Middle Peninsula, they repeatedly tell us that if CA did not exist, they could not have considered relocating to the area and putting down roots here.

It is with a sense of overwhelming appreciation that we share the 2022-2023 Gratitude Report, which highlights the many supporters who help advance the mission, philosophy, and vision of Chesapeake Academy. The Board of Trustees, faculty and staff, parents, students, alumni, alumni parents, grandparents, and community friends contributed over

\$456,000 to support the Bell Tower Annual Giving Fund and special projects.

Annual giving through the Bell Tower Annual Giving Fund remained and remains the life blood of support for Chesapeake Academy. Unrestricted funds donated to the school reach every single student by funding current technology, science equipment, field trips, athletic uniforms, and classroom materials. In addition, gifts to the **Bell Tower Annual Giving Fund** keep tuition affordable for all our families and provide additional financial assistance to half of all enrolled students.

Participation in giving at Chesapeake Academy is affirmation that our community understands the importance of investing in our educational program. Engagement is consistently high with **100% of the Board of Trustees** and **100% of the faculty and staff** ensuring their names are on the donor rolls, while parent participation reached 79% for the year.

The **Oyster Roast** and **Annual Auction** are the school's two major fundraising events, and we were so thankful to be able to have both in person this year after reinventing them in the prior two years. We highlight the work of Catherine Emry, Development Associate, without whom these events wouldn't occur. She has made both events successfully come to fruition with the help of some wonderful key volunteers, among them Beth Somers, Kelly Antonio, Alice Riviere, and Michelle Ritter. These alumni moms, former faculty members, and community leaders step up time and time again to make sure that CA has what it needs.

Chesapeake Academy's standing as a **leading educational institution** could not remain secured without the support of people who believe in the mission of the school and the role CA plays in the community. We were honored for the 11th year in a row by *Virginia Living Magazine* as the **#1 independent school in Eastern Virginia**, with the Oyster Roast ranked as the #1 charity event, Summer Camp ranked as the #1 camp in the region, and CA PreK voted the #1 preschool program.



Your investment in our children's future is evident in the joyful, engaging experience students have at Chesapeake Academy. Even in these times when it is easy to feel discouraged by the adult world, the laughter of children and the consistency of school life give us hope. You help us launch young people who will have the ethical values and critical thinking skills to tackle whatever comes their way.







Annual Operating Fund


